The Webster County Library (WCL) complies with US Copyright Law (Title 17, U.S. Code), which prohibits the unauthorized reproduction or distribution of copyrighted materials, except as permitted by the principles of "fair use." Patrons may copy, scan, or download material under these fair use exceptions. To protect creators' copyrights, WCL will post copyright warning notices at all library machines where material might be copied, scanned, or downloaded. WCL will also honor the rights of film producers by purchasing public performance rights, if appropriate, for library programs/performances. Software licenses will be in compliance with the provisions of U.S. Copyright Law.
